

Conditions of Participation

The competition is divided into four different age groups:

I	Year of birth	2009-2011
II	Year of birth	2006-2008
III	Year of birth	2003-2005
IV	Year of birth	2000-2002

Prize winners (1st prize) of a previous music talent competition can only be re-entered by a higher age group.

For the participation in the competition a fee of €15 is charged (no refund).

In the registration you have to state the competition pieces and their time duration. The grades are to be attached to the registration. For contemporary pieces, the original copy must be presented on the day of the competition. The award winners have to participate in the prizewinner concert.

There can be no répétiteur.

Special regulation: In order to promote the community music in this competition, the young piano accompanists are evaluated separately (for example: Sponsorship prizes).

For registration, the registration form must be completed in full (legible) and the participation fee, in the amount of €15 transferred to the following account:

The Registration and participation fee must be received by the organizer on 16 April 2020. Changes (persons, pieces) are no longer possible after this date. Approval confirmation or rejection (if the requirements are not fulfilled) will be sent by e-mail.

Category I	4- 7 Minuten
Category II	7-12 Minuten
Category III	12-15 Minuten
Category IV	15-20 Minuten

Conditions

In the audition process, participants are free to choose their songs. It should include two pieces from different style epochs and be appropriate to the level of performance of the player.

Arrival, accommodation and meals of the participants / piano attendants are at their own expense. On request we will inform you about accommodation options.

Judges

The judges are recognized musicians and conductors. The decisions of the jury are not contestable. The jury has the right to interrupt the prelude if the performance time is exceeded. If the number of participants is very high, the judge could request the participants to shorten their competition pieces.

Prize

Every participant gets a certificate. The cash prizes are ranked 1, 2 and 3 in the age groups. In addition, special prizes will be awarded (for example, participation in master classes, such as the Mattheiser Summer Academy in Bad Sobernheim, International Music Days in Hofheim or the Involvement).
